

# Leadership Mission Seminar Pakistan



**Evangelical Alliance Pakistan** conducted a Leadership Mission Seminar on August 27, 2021. The seminar was attended by 120 participants representing 24 churches from Pakistan. The participants learned together Biblical principles and strategies on how the Pakistani Church can reach Pakistan with the love of God and how to effectively share the Good News of the Lord Jesus Christ through words and actions.

Participants were divided into groups to further discuss the topics and share ideas on how to bring awareness among the Christian community about the urgency and importance of sharing the Gospel in Pakistan and how church leadership, pastors, youth, women and children can play the role of evangelism and missions in Pakistan.

A significant amount of time was spent on prayers asking God to bring revival in the lives of Pakistani believers and unite the Pakistani church to share the gospel in Pakistan and beyond.
