

## **TWNAF Fathering Movement – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)**

### **1. Who is the organiser of this training?**

We are not an organisation. We are a group of fathers who are all volunteers. We believed that fatherlessness in the cause of many problems in our society and we are committed to seeing godly fatherhood restored in Cambodia.

### **2. Who is this training for?**

This training is for all fathers and men who are committed to becoming better fathers for their family. Men who are not yet married are also welcome to join. For this first run of training, we are especially targeting pastors and leaders of churches and Christian organisations, whom we hope can become Cambodian trainers and actively promote the TWNAF fathering movement in Cambodia in the future.

### **3. Who are the trainers?**

The trainers have all attended the TWNAF programme in the past. The present training team comprises 5 Singaporeans and 1 Cambodian. It is our hope to raise future Cambodian trainers through this first round of training.

### **4. Can non-Christians attend?**

This is a Christian training programme. However, we welcome non-Christians to join if they feel they can benefit from a Christian perspective.

### **5. What language is the training conducted in?**

The training will be conducted mainly in English but Khmer translation will be provided.

### **6. Will there be a certificate awarded to participants?**

This is for the personal development of fathers and hence we will not be awarding any certificate for this training. However, for those who want to be future trainers, a certificate will be awarded when you can attend the Train the Trainers programme in May 2023.

### **7. Can we join the training through zoom?**

All participants must come on-site to attend. There will be small group discussion, prayer and time of ministry for each other. Online participation will not be conducive for all these.

### **8. If we miss this training this time, will there be future runs of this training?**

Yes definitely. It is our prayer that when we build up our pool of Cambodia trainers, we can conduct future training for different churches and organisations. This is how the fathering movement will grow.

### **9. Will you be conducting this training in the provinces in the future?**

While there are no immediate plans now, we are definitely hoping that the movement will spread into the provinces. When our resources build up in the future, conducting the training in the provinces is certainly a possibility.

### **10. Can mothers, wives and ladies attend this training?**

This training is strictly only for fathers and men. The training will hope to provide a safe space for men to share vulnerably and honestly with each other. However, we are exploring the possibility of bringing Mother's Design (for mothers and ladies) to Cambodia in the future.
